SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

To enter into any arrangement with any governments or authorities that may seem conducive to the Organization's objects or any of them, and to obtain from such government or authority any rights, privileges and concessions which the Organization may think desirable to obtain;

To take such steps by personal or written appeals, public meetings or otherwise as may from time to time be deemed expedient for the purpose of procuring contributions to the funds of the Organization in the form of donations, annual subscription or otherwise;

The specific objectives to achieve or goals are:

-To provide youth a better understanding of entrepreneurship and the role of non-formal learning in supporting entrepreneurship among young people.

YOUTH ENTREPRENEURSHIP SKILLS (YES) CLINICS

- -To give youth practical methods, tools and practices that they can adopt and adapt to their context and so make it easier to gain employment and / or promote entrepreneurship among young people.
- -To promote peer learning activities in order to enhance the skills and competences of youth in delivering entrepreneurial learning.
- -To explore existing programs supporting youth employment and youth entrepreneurship.

The project will be managed by partners in a collaborative way, based on collective intelligence and regular communication.

The project will have direct, positive effects on the different participants as they will acquire more specialized knowledge on entrepreneurial education and the importance of entrepreneurship for young people, transversal competences, perception of self-esteem and a positive sense of belonging to the wider community, and through the peer-learning among youth workers there will be concrete opportunities of intercultural contact as well as up-skilling professional competences.
